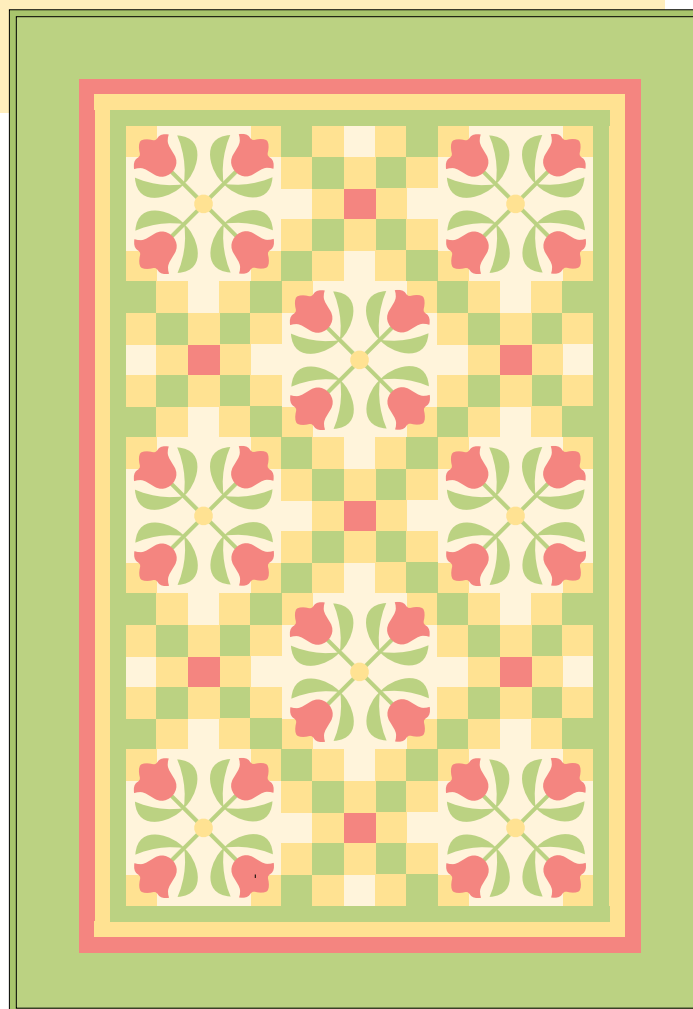
QN's newest free quilt pattern invites a stroll down the garden path. Straightforward piecing and elegant applique combine for beautiful results—a garden you can enjoy all year long!

ASSEMBLY

1 Wash and press fabrics. Cut the patches and strips listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams. Prepare the applique patches according to your favorite method of applique. The yardage requirements allow for turned-edge applique. Set the applique patches aside.

2 Referring to the block Y piecing diagram, join 4 yellow A's, 4 light yellow B's, and a light yellow C to make a block Y. Make 8 block Y's.

3 Referring to the block Z piecing diagram, join 8 green A's, 12 yellow A's, 4 light yellow A's, and 1 pink A as shown to complete block Z. Make 7 block Z's. ▶



MATERIALS AND CUTTING

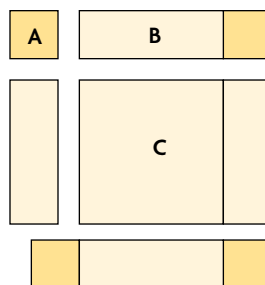
Requirements are based on 40" fabric width. Border measurements are the exact length required plus seam allowances.

BLOCK SIZE: 10"

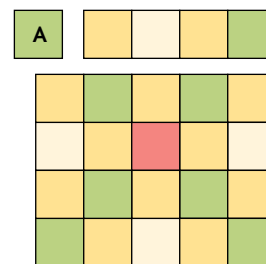
QUILT SIZE: 44" x 64"

MATERIALS	YDS.	CUTTING
Yellow	1	116 A, 8 circles, 2 borders 1½" x 52½", 2 borders 1½" x 34½"
Lt. Yellow	1	28 A, 32 B, 8 C
Green	2½	56 A, 64 leaves, 32 stems, 2 borders 1½" x 50½", 2 borders 1½" x 32½", 2 borders 4½" x 56½", 2 borders 4½" x 44½", 6 strips binding 2¼" x 40"
Pink	¾	7 A, 32 flowers, 2 borders 1½" x 54½", 2 borders 1½" x 36½"
Backing	3	2 horizontal panels 48" x 35"
Batting		48" x 68"

TECHNIQUES USED: machine piecing, hand or machine applique, machine quilting

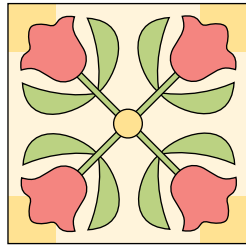


BLOCK Y PIECING
Make 8



BLOCK Z PIECING
Make 7

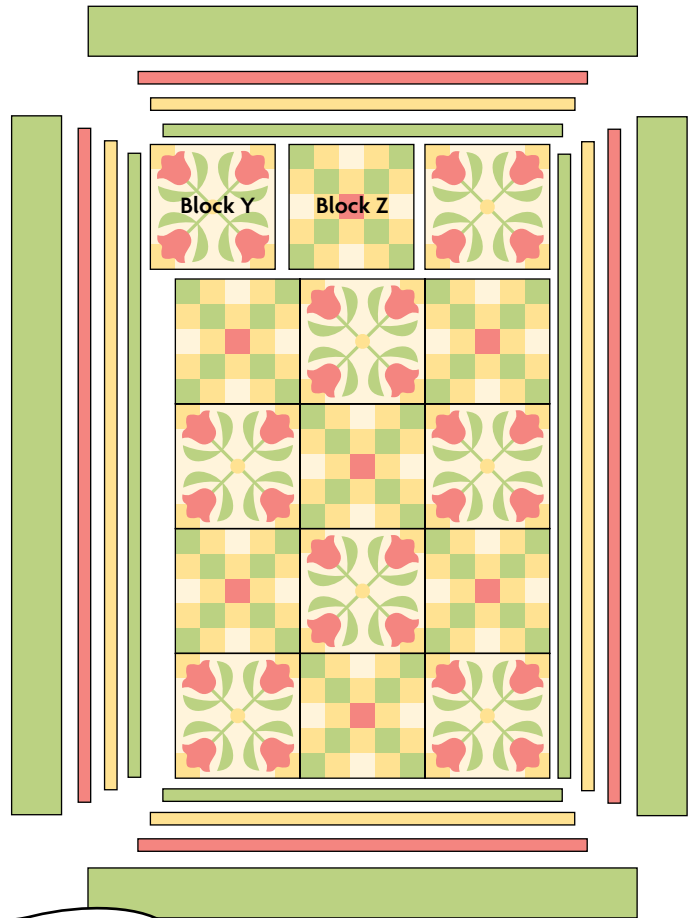
4 Referring to the applique placement diagram, applique the leaves, stems, flowers, and circles on a block Y. Repeat for all block Y's.



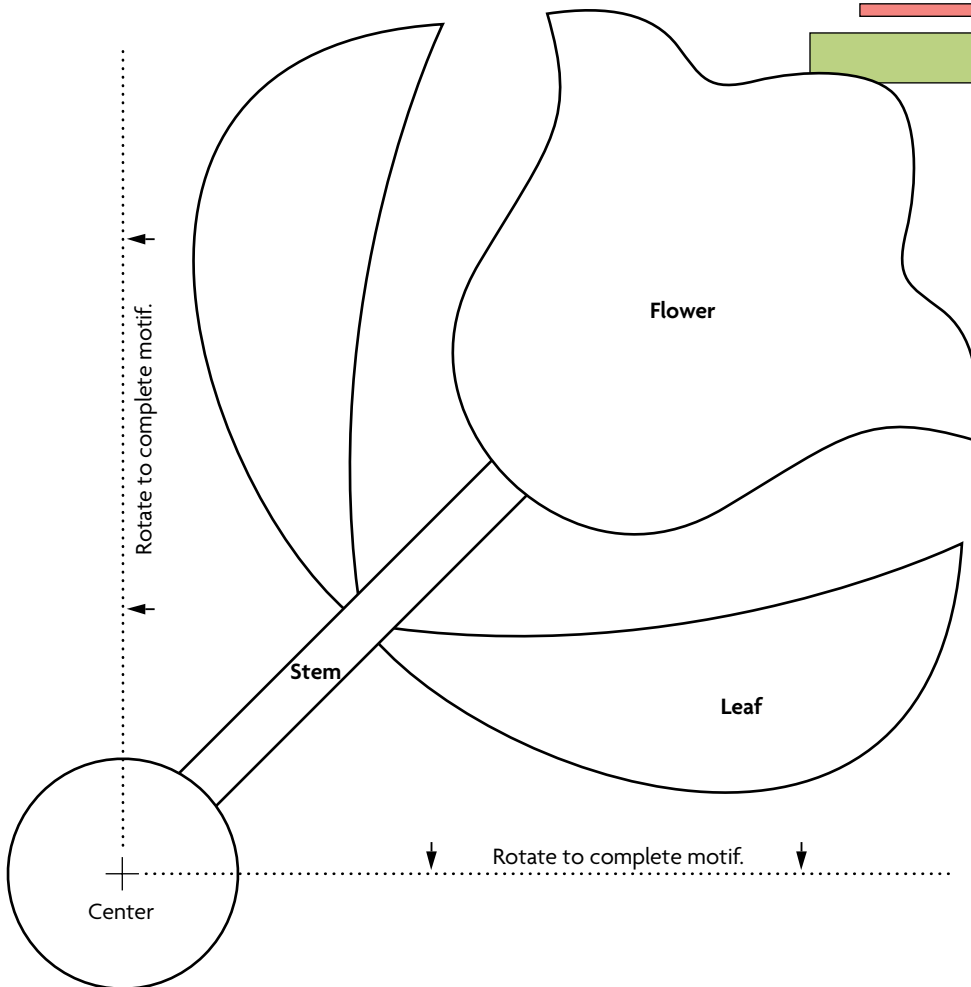
APPLIQUE PLACEMENT

5 Referring to the quilt assembly diagram, join the blocks into rows as shown. Join the rows. Sew a longer thin green border to each side of the quilt center, matching centers and ends. Press the seam allowances toward the borders. Matching centers and ends, sew the top and bottom thin green borders to the quilt. Press the seam allowances toward the borders. Repeat to add the yellow, pink, and wide green borders.

6 Layer and baste the backing, batting, and quilt top. Stitch in the ditch between the blocks and borders. Quilt a floral motif in the block Z's. Echo quilt around the applique. Quilt the flower and leaf shapes onto the borders or quilt the borders as desired. Bind the quilt to finish.



QUILT ASSEMBLY



ROTARY CUTTING

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.
